

Richard C. Holbrooke Former U.S. Ambassador to the United Nations


Richard Holbrooke may be the world's premier negotiator. He arranged an agreement bringing the U.S. back into good standing with the United Nations, and was chief negotiator at the 1995 Dayton Peace Agreement, which ended the war in Bosnia. He has had six Nobel Peace Prize nominations. Holbrooke served as U.S. Ambassador to the United Nations and earlier held a variety of diplomatic positions, as well as being vice chairman of CS First Boston and a managing director of Lehman Brothers.

Holbrooke discusses managing crises through calm leadership and determination, and reviews the considerations that must be taken when quiding American strategic interests.



John Walsh
America's Most Wanted

John Walsh is widely recognized as a tireless advocate for victims' rights and missing children as host of the nation's number-one crime-fighting show, *America's Most Wanted: America Fights Back* and also his own daily talk show. Law Enforcement officials around the nation have honored Walsh for his efforts. He has received the FBI's highest civilian award, and is the only private citizen to receive a Special Recognition Award by a U.S. Attorney General. He has been honored four times by three presidents, and was recently asked by Colin Powell and President Bush to do a special *America's Most Wanted* featuring the 22 terrorists that now top the FBI's most wanted list.
